# 3b Workplan update (1)

#### **Workstream conveners**

- We have 4 workstream conveners...
  - Grace Burtin = Market Frameworks
  - Terry Paddy = Digitalisation
  - Stuart Johnston = Flexible resource integration and visibility
  - Tom Rose = Consumer information and participation
- The workstream convener collective (+ Steve and Craig) met 10 November and will meet monthly to coordinate workplan activities, consider resourcing, share progress and information, manage demarcation disputes, and other useful activities
  - need to think about formalising the interaction between the workstream convener collective and the Steering Group [do this after 30 November]
- The next convener catchup is 23 November to review the proposed tasks and confirm a proposed 2024 workplan to take to the FlexForum session on 30 November
  - a proposed 2024 workplan and the long list of tasks will be shared with FlexForum Members on 27 November 2023

# 3b Workplan update (2)

## Scoping of tasks to go into the 2024 workplan

- 24 ideas/tasks emerged from the workstream kickoff sessions roughly grouped according to workstream (this is indicative!), but the scoping process is reorganising/merging tasks
  - 4 digitalisation (4)
  - 6 flexible resource integration (2)
  - 7 market frameworks (7)
  - 7 consumer participation (2)
- Very clear theme is to understand the fundamentals first. Most ideas/tasks focus on Discovery. Some focus on Refinement. A fair way from developing specific solutions and implementation...
- Several tasks have common elements, eg, rest on assumptions about the future state or describing use cases,
   which will be coordinated through the workstream conveners
- 2 further activities will be recognised as tasks in the workplan
  - Update the Flexibility Plan
  - Responding to regulators, eg, Commerce Commission, 2025 DPP Issues Paper, submissions due Friday 15 December 2023

# 3c Finance update (1)

### 2024 subscriptions

# 3c Finance update (2)

#### **Current and forecast budget position**

- income is expected to exceed minimum necessary outgoings for the period to 29 February and for the period to 31 August 2024
  - assumes Independent Chair + 1 contracted person + basic comms + running costs
  - includes EECA funding as 'committed', ie, contract will be signed when scope of tasks is finalised (expected this week)
  - allowance for website etc only if Ara Ake money lands
- surplus funds are sufficient to buy an indicative 350 hours (to 28/02) up to 1000 hours (to 31/08) of 'extra' workstream support

ACTION: agree to contract extra workstream support up to 350 hours and up to 1000 hours if Ara Ake funding is received

# 4a Fill the Steering Group vacancy (1)

## Purpose of this item:

Fill the Steering Group vacancy

The Steering Group needs to appoint at least one new member. You were asked on 20 October to suggest people to fill 1 or 2 vacancies indicating how they met the criteria for SG members and ensured SG membership reflects the diverse and whole-of-ecosystem interests and participation in FlexForum

- any vacancy in the number of members of the Steering Group may be filled by the Steering Group. Any person so appointed will hold office
  until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting.
- to be part of the Steering Group you must be a Member of the FlexForum (or work for a Member). Members will act in their personal capacity and not as representatives of their employer or organisation.

# 4a Fill the Steering Group vacancy (2)

#### Criteria

 Implications of suggestions for diversity of SG membership

The interest and availability of the suggestions has not been confirmed

6.4 Steering Group members should be selected based on the following criteria:

- (a) to ensure the Steering Group membership reflects the diverse and whole-of-supply chain Interests and participation in the FlexForum and will provide Members with confidence that the Steering Group will act in the best interests of the FlexForum, its objectives and purpose, rather than specific sectoral or organisational interests;
- able to demonstrate a clear commitment to the objective and purpose of the FlexForum and the Flexibility Plan;
- (c) an ability for independent thinking, pragmatism, and a preference for learning by doing;
- (d) an ability to see the big picture and knowing when to get into the detail;
- (e) an ability to collaborate, recognise different perspectives, ask challenging questions and to be challenged
- (f) any other criteria set out in the Policies and Procedures.

ACTION: approve to appoint one or two people to fill a vacancy on the Steering Group until the AGM, subject to them being a Member and confirming they are both interested and available

# 4b Approve a Membership policy

## Purpose of this item:

to approve adding a Membership policy to FlexForum Policies and Procedures

Action 5.1 from the 10 October SG meeting was 'Develop guidelines setting out the approach and principles to consistently decide membership requests, ie, a membership policy'.

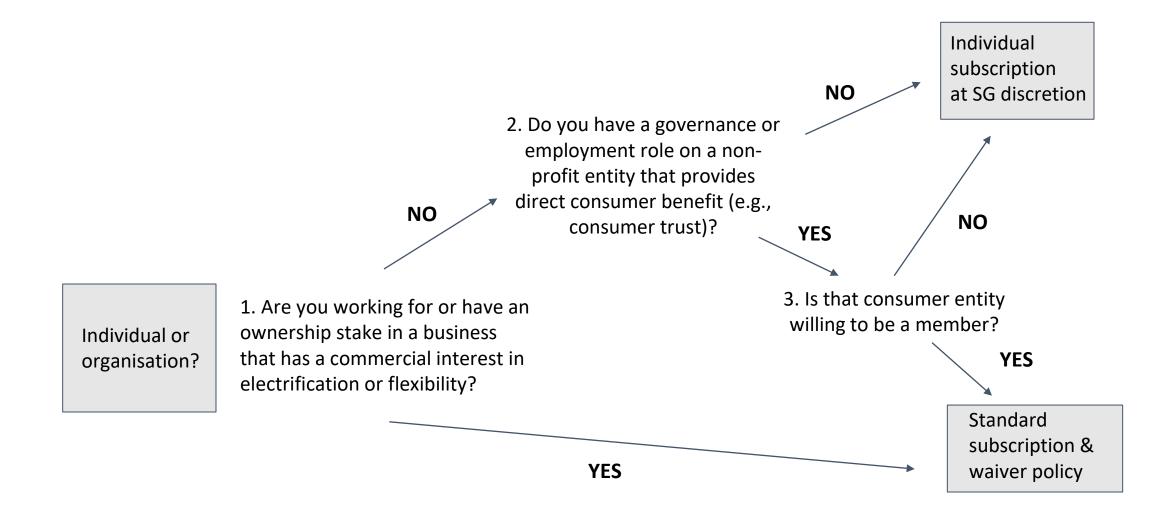

The key elements of the Membership Policy are:

- provide guidance about the requirements to apply as 'an individual who is a consumer' (see over)
- the Membership application process
- enabling the independent chair to approve Membership requests on behalf of the Steering Group in some cases

ACTION: approve Policies and Procedures version 2 including a Membership Policy

# 4b Subscription waiver considerations

Inclusivity and diversity of members is consistent with the FlexForum's purpose (Constitution 3.2). While the marginal cost of adding members is very low, there are pragmatic limits (some financial) to the extent we can admit members without subscriptions:

- It dishonours the contribution of subscription-paying members;
- It will challenge the financial viability of the FlexForum where the lost subscription fees is material

As a result, the subscription policy allows the SG complete discretion to reduce or waive subscriptions in some circumstances (essentially trying to deal with the opportunity cost)

- Some reductions/waivers will be granted on a clear quid pro quo basis (e.g., Universities) the FlexForum would be poorer as a result of not having this material contribution.
- But there are also situations where small entities simply cannot afford to join as they are in the startup phase with low or zero operating surpluses. These entities would add to the diversity of the FlexForum.
- In these situations, the SG should consider granting a first-year reduction or waiver.

# 4c Decide Membership requests (1)

Membership requests received from 6 organisations/people since September which need to be decided. A recommendation is provided for each based on the draft Membership Policy

- 3 membership requests from organisations seeking a waiver/reduction to the annual subscription
- 2 membership requests from people wanting to join as individuals who are consumers.

**ACTION:** decide whether to allow the applicants to become a Member
